The Five Stages Of The Process

Stage One: We Must Plant The Seed

- In order to plant the seed we must be willing to let it go. You can't hold on to your seed and expect a harvest.
- Usually the seed is buried underneath the surface covered by dirt.

Stage Two: We Must Water Where We have Planted

- Without the proper amount of water even the best seed planted in the best dirt will not survive.
- From a spiritual perspective our seeds are often watered by our trials and tribulations, as pointed out in Psalms 126:6(NIV),

"Those who go out weeping carrying seed to sow, will return with songs of joy carrying the harvest with them."

Stage Three: We Must Fertilize Where We Have Planted

- Fertilization is a vital part of the seeds development.
- Fertilizers are nutrients that allow seeds planted to grow into healthy crops.

Stage Four: We Must Keep The Weeds Under Control

- We will never eliminate all weeds all the time, but we must not allow them to take over.
- Weeds are persistent enemies of a successful harvest. If not appropriately dealt with they will kill, steal and destroy what could have been a blessed harvest.

Stage Five: We Must Patiently Wait On The Increase

- After we have endured the process of planting and nurturing, we must then patiently wait on the increase.
- God is the one who provides the increase; He alone deserves the credit and the praise for the blessing of the harvest!
